




Social Value Snapshot 2024-25



SIL awarded £14,553.40 of charitable fund grants to service users, staff and local organisations, these included short breaks for service users, promoting their wellbeing.



9,121.2 KG Of CO2 was saved by SIL office staff homeworking and not commuting to the office in their cars, reducing air pollution and contributing to a more sustainable environment.



SIL raised £512.13 through various social activities with service users and staff to support our charity of the year Marches Family Network.



SIL Hosted over 350 hours of social events for service users and staff, preventing loneliness and encouraging new friendships and networks of support.



14.5% of SIL's employees are disabled, SIL is committed to supporting people with disabilities both in the workplace and in the wider community.



SIL Spent over £50,000 on goods and services from local businesses. SIL is committed to using local SMEs and VCSEs wherever possible.



SIL Recruits 42 % of staff from economically deprived areas. SIL also offers a wellbeing assistance programme to support all staff.



Since the insulation of the office solar panels SIL has saved £7,815 in electricity costs and 546kg of CO2 equal to a round-trip flight from London to Paris!
